Coaching for 2011 - 2012!

This year all Coaches need to register themselves online starting June 1st! Coaches are entered into the Hockey Canada Registration system the same way as players, but for yourself, choose 'register a new participant' and select the Coach or Asst Coach Package. This will allow us to have your file complete and do any follow-up with you during the summer months. Completing an Application for Registration through the HCR system does not guarantee a position as a Coach, Asst Coach, or other on a team.

Registration for 2011-2012!

Registration for the 2011 -2012 season will begin with online registration open June 1st!

We will have two In-person registrations that will be held Wednesday, June 1 from 6 pm - 9 pm and

Saturday, June 18th from 10am - 2 pm, both at the Kinsmen Arena lobby.



In order for registration to be accepted the Registration form (both sides) or online submission must be completed in full, with any necessary documents and payment included.

Returning players will receive a Registration Package in the mail and can register online, at one of the two in-person days, or by mail. Registrations for returning players must be received by July 31, 2011 to avoid a \$100 late registration fee. New players are not subject to a late registration fee.

New Players can register online, at one of the two in-person days, or by mail, and must include a copy of their Birth Certificate OR Passport, **AND** a copy of their Alberta Health Care Card **AND** Proof of Residency (utility bill or drivers license). You may only register with Confederation Hockey if you reside within the Confederation area of the SWZone of Edmonton on September 1, 2011.

Transferring players must register by paper only. Players transferring from another club are also considered new players and need to provide the same documentation listed above **AS WELL AS** a Parent Declaration form. Parent Declaration forms can be found on our website. Please list the previous club on the registration form. The Confederation Registrar will attempt to obtain a release/transfer from the previous club.

Community Leagues

A Community League Membership is no longer required to play within Hockey Edmonton. Confederation Hockey strongly encourages our members to continue to support their community and the programs and services they offer by purchasing a 2011-2012 Membership.

You can purchase your membership through the EFCL website at www.efcl.org or, through your individual community leagues membership person.

Confederation Hockey will not be selling or collecting for community league memberships this year.

PWAA (Tier 1) and Atom Tier 1 Tryouts

If your <u>Peewee</u> player would like to tryout for the Peewee AA (Tier 1) team this year, you need to select the Non-Refundable Peewee Tier One Tryout Fee (\$75) on your Paper or Online Registration. The deadline for registering for tryouts is July 31st - NO EXCEPTIONS.

Tryout out for PWAA is optional. PWAA tryouts will start August 20, 2011.

Questions should be directed to the Peewee Directors.

If your <u>Atom</u> player would like to tryout for the Atom Tier 1 team this year, you need to select the Non-Refundable Atom Tier One Tryout Fee (\$50) on your Paper or Online Registration. **The deadline for registering for tryouts is July 31st - NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Tryout out for Atom Tier 1 is optional. Atom Tier 1 tryouts will start August 25, 2011. Questions should be directed to the Atom Directors.

Player Evaluations

IN 1A does not take part in Evaluations. IN 2A only has Evaluations to place the players on even teams. The purpose of evaluations at Novice, Atom, and Peewee are to tier the players with similar ability level players. The only two teams that have a paid tryout are the PWAA (Tier 1) and the Atom Tier 1. The tryout fee strictly covers the additional pre-season ice cost that is needed for these tryouts.

All players will participate in regular Evaluations in order to be placed on an appropriate team, with the exception of the players selected to the PWAA and Atom Tier 1 teams.

Evaluations will be done in Club this coming season as outside evaluation is a costly item. Ideally, evaluators will work outside of their child's category. We believe we have the skills and people to make our evaluations effective and objective. If you are interested in helping with Evaluations this year, please indicate your willingness on your registration - online or paper.

have a New Player - What do I do?

Firstly - Welcome to Confed!

One of the first things we need to do is confirm that your residence is in the Confed Hockey area. You must live within the Confederation Area of the SWZone of Edmonton as of September 1, 2011 in order to play with Confed. We encourage you to consider where your child's friends, neighbours, and school mates play to make it a more



enjoyable experience for them. Ask people you know that are in hockey about their club. New Players can register online or by paper, either mailed in or at in person - June 1 from 6 - 9pm and June 18 from 10am - 2 pm, both at the Kinsmen Arena (on 111St by the Y). You must include a copy of the players Birth Certificate OR Passport AND a copy of the players Alberta Health Care Card AND Proof of Residency (utility bill showing address and parent name). You can find a "New Parent's Survival Guide" on the Confed website at www.confedhockey.org, that you may find helpful answering your questions.
